- **NAWALT:**

- **Normies**

- In the incelosphere, a normie (also known as an NPC) constitutes those between a "4" or a "6" on the decile scale. (incels.wiki)

- **Chad**

- A Chad constitutes anything from a "8" to a "10" on the decile scale; the polar opposite of a truecel. In terms of personality, he is your high school bully. He is now the guy who works on Wall Street, who gets on TV, or who plays for a pro-sports team. Chad can get nearly any woman he wants based on his high sexual market value, but tends to go for Stacy (incels.wiki)

- Stacy is the ultimate embodiment of every wicked, depraved aspect of feminine nature. A stereotypical mean girl, or cheerleader, who is able to secure sexual intimacy with Chad. (incels.wiki)

- Beta

- social hierarchy
- Beta males are followers; they are subservient to alphas. (incel.wiki)

- Blackpill

- (incelosphere sense) being pessimistic due to awareness of the fatalism inherent within genetic determinism and that self-improvement to increase SMV is pointless for those who have lost the genetic lottery. (Urban Dictionary)
- There are also Bluepills (refers to someone who has not been enlightened to the harsh realities of the world) and Redpills (the opposite of bluepills). (Incel Wiki)

- Cucky

- An affectionate term for a cuckold, usually uttered by the wife or cuckoldress (Urban Dictionary)

- Fritzlmaxx

- v. To lock someone in the basement for 24 years and impregnate them repeatedly. (Urban Dictionary)

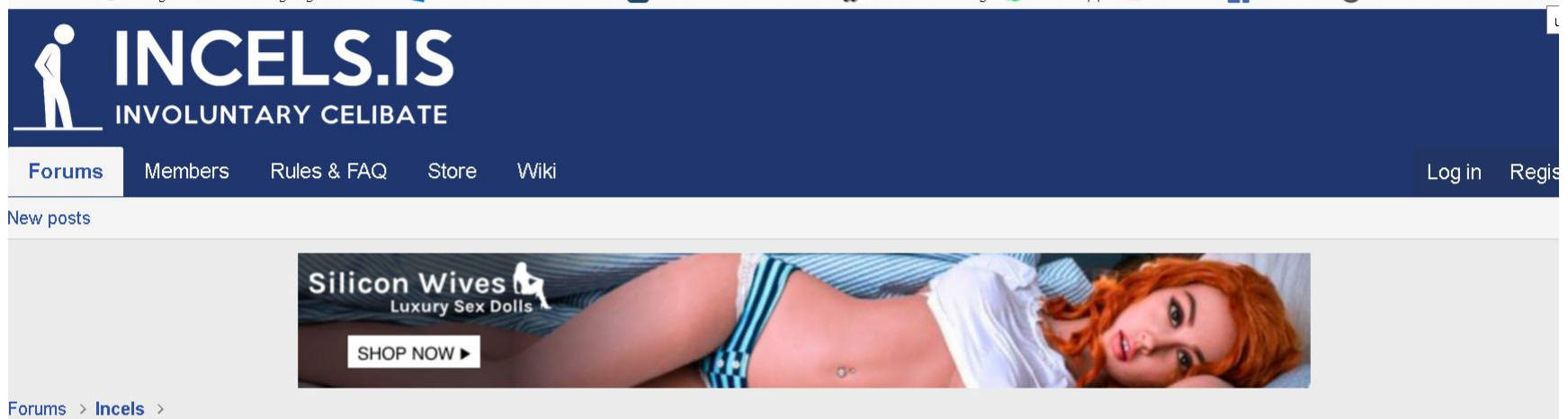

Rules and Terminology

Users

- **Incel (Allowed):** Person who desires, but is unable, to be in a romantic relationship.
- **Blackpilled (Conditional):** Person who is not currently incel, but agrees with most views portrayed in the forum.
- **Female (Not Allowed):** Banned on sight, no exceptions.

Rules

- **Bragging:** No (discussing nor requesting) personal romantic or sexual experiences, even if they happened long ago. No humble-bragging. [Looksmax.me](#) is more suitable to discuss these things. Heavy bragging outside of incels.is may carry a warning/ban.
- **Users:** No persecution, bullying, sharing accounts, or posting on behalf of banned users.
- **Behavior:** No trolling, baiting, white-knighting, misinformation, platitudes, mass PMing, or arbitrary necroposting.
- **Content:** No low effort, spam, advertisement, all-caps, or selfies. No avatars nor signatures that are NSFW or worship.
- **NSFW Content:** Pornography and violent content needs a [NSFW] tag if thread, spoiler tags if post.
- **Disallowed:**
 - Ratings (use [looksmax.me](#)).
 - Traps, gay content, worship, and praise (of both males and females).
 - Cherry-picking (e.g. unattractive men with girlfriends).
 - Requesting a ban (PM a mod instead).
 - Clarification on warnings / bans (use megathread in Meta).
 - Discussion of illegal activities.
 - Having more than a single alternate account.

Membership criteria I: membership and rules

— — —

Membership:

- is the selection given? only male? can women be incels?
- can membership be negotiated?

Hierarchy:

- official supporters, submitters, Green, Orange, Blue

Membership criteria II

— — —

Access criteria:

- Generally open, no specific skill is required

Temporal aspects / duration:

- lifelong vs. maturation vs. Selfdetermined
- Permanent vs. Intermittent, sporadic
- intermittent?

Spatial aspect:

- spatially independent, online forum, accessible from everywhere
- incelosphere:
 - A network of websites and forums that are visited by incelospherians. (Urban Dictionary)

Membership criteria III

— — —

Benefit:

- support?
- socially/economically beneficial to members
- socially/economically detrimental to members
- Access to power
- Exclusion from power

Common goal:

- Goal-oriented for the individual
- Goal-oriented for the community
- Is there a common goal? What is the common goal?

Conclusion

- shows the impact of the internet in forming spatially independent communities
- Nothing can be completely deleted and banned from the internet
- incels.wiki > creation of wiki for in-terms and concepts shows the exclusivity of the group and the importance of language to the construction of communities
